

## CES PTA After School Programs – Winter 2012 Schedule of Classes and Registration Form

**REGISTRATION DEADLINE: Tuesday January 24, 2012**

**No registration forms will be accepted after the deadline.**

### **DATES & TIMES:**

Starting dates for the programs begin as noted on the schedule. Each class meets once a week (see attached schedule for number of weeks) and begins after all students are dismissed at the end of the school day. There will be no class if school is cancelled or dismissed early. Make-up classes will be added to the end of the session unless you are notified otherwise. Classes are one hour, unless otherwise noted on the schedule. Please arrive promptly to pick up your child. **A fee of \$5 for every 10 minutes will be charged for late pick ups.**

### **REGISTRATION:**

- To enroll in any class, please complete the attached registration form.
- **If the number of registrations received in the PTA file drawer by 3 p.m. on Tuesday, January 24, 2012 exceeds the class limit, participants will be chosen by lottery.**
- Confirmations will be sent via email. Please include your email address on the registration form.
- Please place the signed registration form and payment(s) in an envelope marked “After School Programs” and return it to your child’s homeroom teacher (or the PTA mailbox) by **3 pm on Tuesday, January 24, 2012.**

### **VOLUNTEERS:**

In accordance with Howard County PTA guidelines, each class must have two unrelated adults present at all times. Most of the program instructors have chosen to fulfill this requirement by offering reduced tuition to the child of a parent who volunteers to attend all of the program sessions for the semester. If you wish to volunteer, please contact Linda Thomsen (contact information below) as soon as possible. Please note: if no one volunteers for a program, that program may need to be canceled.

### **PAYMENT POLICY:**

Please **make checks payable to the teacher of the after school program or to the sponsoring organization.** The teacher’s name (or sponsoring organization’s name) is listed next to the program title on the attached schedule of After School Programs. If you are registering your child for more than one program, write a separate check for each program.

### **ATTENDANCE & SAFETY:**

Remind your child to stay after school on his/her program day, and please send a note to your child’s teacher every day that the program is held informing the teacher that your child will be staying after school. In addition, if your child cannot attend a program on a particular day, please let your child’s teacher know. The After School Program will not refund any portion of the program fee for missed classes.
