Schedule of Classes and Registration Form

Attached is a list and description of the After School Programs that will be offered in the Spring semester. A registration form is also attached. Classes are open to all Clarksville Elementary School students, according to the grade levels indicated.

DATES & TIMES:

Starting dates for the programs begin as noted on the schedule. Each class meets once a week (see attached schedule for number of weeks) and begins after all students are dismissed at the end of the school day. There will be no class if school is cancelled or dismissed early. Make-up classes will be added to the end of the session unless you are notified otherwise. Classes are one hour, unless otherwise noted on the schedule. Please arrive promptly to pick up your child. **A fee of \$5 for every 10 minutes will be charged for late pick ups.**

REGISTRATION:

- To enroll in any class, please complete the attached registration form.
- **If the number of registrations received in the PTA file drawer by 3 p.m. on March 1 exceeds the class limit, participants will be chosen by lottery.**
- All confirmations will be sent via email. Please include your email address on the registration form.
- Please place the signed registration form and payment(s) in an envelope marked “After School Programs” and return it to your child’s homeroom teacher (or the PTA mailbox) by **Monday March 1, 2010.**

PAYMENT POLICY:

Please **make all checks payable to the teacher of the after school program or to the sponsoring organization.** The teacher’s name/organization is listed next to the program title on the attached schedule of After School Programs. If you are registering your child for more than one program, write a separate check for each program. (Note: The class fees include \$15 to support the CES PTA.)

ATTENDANCE & SAFETY:

Please remind your child to stay after school on his/her program day. Homeroom teachers will be given a list of students enrolled in the programs. Each program instructor will take attendance. If your child cannot attend a program, please send a note to his/her homeroom teacher. If a child does not bring a note and is not absent from school that day, but fails to show up for his/her program, the parents will be informed by telephone. The After School Program will not refund any portion of the program fee for missed classes.
